Step 1: Full course analysis

The area to be managed will be discussed during an orientation meeting, with an emphasis on the character, the vision for the future and wishes.



Step 2: Zero measurement

The current situation is inventoried during the zero measurement and the results will be considered as starting point for the process.



Step 3: Soil analysis

Then the structure and composition of the soil is examined.



Step 4: Cultural and game technical aspects

We, in consultation with you, prepare realistic objectives that are suitable within the desired framework.



Step 5: Maintenance plan

The desired objectives are transformed into a tailor-made management plan. This plan will include, among other things, Integrated Turf Management, Non-chemical Turfgrass Management and GEO-agreements.



Step 6: Machine plan
